<p><b>Category I - Core Privileges:</b> To be eligible for core privileges, applicants must have completed an ACGME-approved Pathology residency program and be Board Certified or be a candidate for Board Certification. <b>Core privileges are as follows:</b></p>		
<p><b>Anatomic Pathology:</b> to be eligible for Anatomic Pathology privileges, applicants must be Board Certified or be a candidate for Board Certification in Anatomic Pathology. Certification or eligibility in Clinical Pathology is desirable. <b>Anatomic privileges are as follows:</b></p> <p><b>Prepares or supervises:</b> description and examination of gross tissue specimens; selection of appropriate blocks for sectioning; tissues for microscopic examination including frozen sections and a variety of special stains and special microscopic techniques, i.e. electron microscopy and immunofluorescence; diagnosis of all material submitted, transmitting appropriate information to submitting physicians.</p> <p><b>Consults with other physicians;</b></p> <p><b>Examines patients as deemed necessary;</b></p> <p><b>Participates in evaluation of various surgical or other procedures accomplished or proposed by hospital staff;</b></p> <p><b>Prepares reports on students and housestaff and accepts or rejects as deemed appropriate by him;</b></p> <p><b>Performs needle aspiration at superficial lesions in consultation with other physicians.</b></p>	_____	_____

<p><b>Clinical Pathology:</b> to be eligible for Clinical Pathology privileges, applicants must be Board Certified or be a candidate for Board Certification in Clinical Pathology. Certification or eligibility in Anatomic Pathology is desirable.  <b>Clinical Pathology privileges are as follows:</b></p> <p><b>Prepares or supervises, when requested: Collection of blood by venepuncture; Various staining and biochemical procedures in material from patients; Examination by all types of microscopy of patient materials; Interpretation of any or all findings;</b></p> <p><b>Consults with other physicians, including examination of patients, as requested;</b></p> <p><b>Treats patients with certain diseases in consultation with other physicians, e.g., therapeutic apheresis or transfusions;</b></p> <p><b>Participates in evaluation of various diagnostic procedures performed by the hospital staff.</b></p>	_____	_____
<p><b>Category II:</b> to be eligible for Category II privileges, applicants must have completed an ACGME approved Pathology residency program, <i>be Board Certified or Equivalent</i>, and provide documentation as to additional course work and recent experience. <b>Category II privileges are as follows:</b></p>		
<p><b>Category III:</b> to be eligible for Category III privileges, applicants must have completed an ACGME approved _____ fellowship program, <i>be Board Certified or be a candidate for Board Certification</i>, and have completed fellowship and provide documentation as to course work and recent experience. <b>Category III privileges are as follows:</b></p>
