



Thank you for your interest in a student rotation at the R Adams Cowley Shock Trauma Center. Here is some basic information about our educational opportunities:

We primarily offer Nurse Practitioner student rotation for Acute/Critical Care NP students. We can occasionally place primary care NP students with our orthopaedics team or acute pain management team.

We have a limited ability to provide rotations for PA students. We typically accept PA students who have significant healthcare experience and are comfortable having Nurse Practitioners as preceptors for part of their rotation.

Rotations are typically intense and can range from 30-80 hours per week of clinical time with some (limited) flexibility.

We do not provide housing or transportation.

The process for arranging a rotation is as follows:

1) Determine if the UMMC has an affiliation agreement with your school by contacting Cyndy Ronald, Manager, School of Nursing Partnership, UMMC, Clinical Practice and Professional Development: CRONALD@umm.edu. If we do not have an agreement with your program, Cyndy can attempt to help you arrange this.

2) Send:

- § A copy of your resume and
- § A document listing your educational goals to kandersen2@umm.edu.
 - These goals can simple “learn to manage trauma patients through the course of their illness” or specific “learn different ways of treating traumatic brain injury”.
- § We will contact you if we are unable to meet your educational needs.

3) Once an agreement between UMMC and your program is reached, contact Brooke Andersen (kandersen2@umm.edu.) to discuss scheduling.
